

<b>Ink for Stamping</b>	<b>Paper</b>	<b>Coloring Tools</b>	<b>Explanation</b>
Light Ink (Sahara Sand, Crumb Cake, etc.)	Watercolor	Get ink in the lid of your regular ink pad.  Water Painter	Using the Water Painters, use the ink in the lid of the ink pad to color your stamped image.
Staz-On	Shimmery Paper	Watercolor Pencils  Water Painters	Color your stamped image with the pencils and then use the Water Painters to blend.
-	Shimmery Paper	Ink Pads (in the lid)  Bowl of water  Water Painters	Using the Water Painter and the bowl of water, brush on water on the paper. Then, use the Water Painter with the ink in the lids to brush across for a background.
Regular Ink Pads	Watercolor	Water Painters	After stamping your image, use the Water Painter to drag the color inside your stamped image.
Versamark w/ embossing powder	Watercolor	Ink Refills  Acrylic Blocks  Water Painters	Put drops of ink refills on the block. Use the Water Painter with the ink drops to color your images.
Staz-On	Shimmery Paper	Soft Pastels  Water Painters	Rub some of the Soft Pastels (like you're writing or coloring with them) on scrap paper. Use the Water Painter with the Pastels on the scrap paper to color your images.
-	Watercolor Paper Or Shimmery Paper	Embossing Folder  Any type of coloring-ink pads, watercolor pencils, soft pastels  Water Painters	Emboss your paper. Using the Water Painters and any time of coloring, color the embossed images.
